Pre-Cam Extracurricular Goals and Expectations

Academic achievement is the #1 school priority!

Goals:

- To support our curriculum goals and objectives for Gr. 1-6 students.
- To engage our students in a variety of activities and to help improve student attendance.
- To develop school spirit and help students feel a sense of belonging.

Expectations of students:

- **Academics 1st** – Students are expected to keep up and do their best in their school work. Those that do not may be asked to complete their assignments before going to extracurricular activities.
- **Behaviour (4 B's)** – Students are expected to BE responsible, BE respectful, BE safe and BE kind when participating in extracurricular activities. Contact will be made home if there are any repeated behavioral issues.
- **Fair Play/Sportsmanship** – Students are expected to give their best effort, demonstrate good sportsmanship, be a good teammate and follow the directions/expectations of the coach or leader.
- **Attendance** – Students are expected to be committed to their activity by attending regularly. If students miss practice regularly, they may risk their spot on the team or have less playing time than students who have shown up regularly.

Expectations of parents:

- **Transportation** - It is the parents' responsibility to pick up your child on time after the activity is done out of respect for the volunteer coach and leader. Please contact school ahead of time if alternate arrangements have been made for pick up.
- **Communication** - To help us communicate activity cancellations and other important activity information with parents and guardians, we ask that parents include their emails on the registration form.
- **Volunteers** - The extracurricular program relies solely on staff, parent or community volunteers to help run activities for our students. Due to restrictions and for safety reasons, only fully vaccinated staff can lead activities.
