

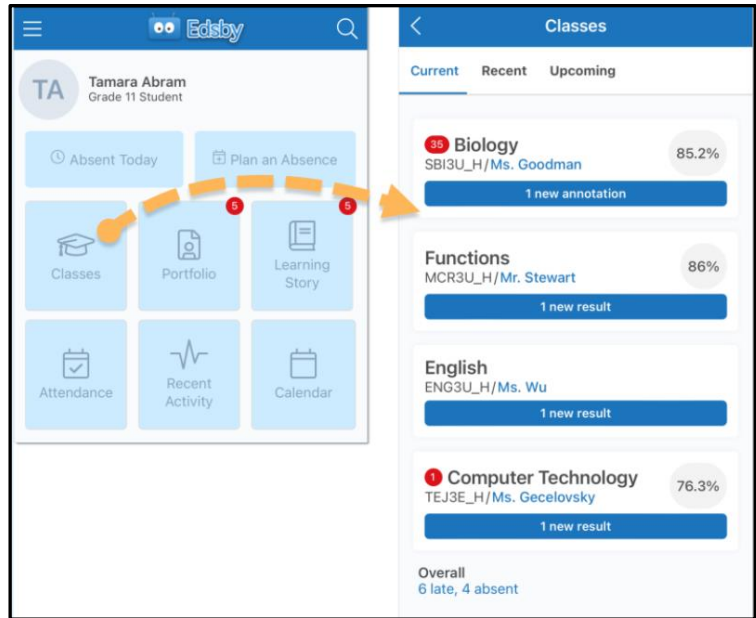


# Viewing Your Child's Classes

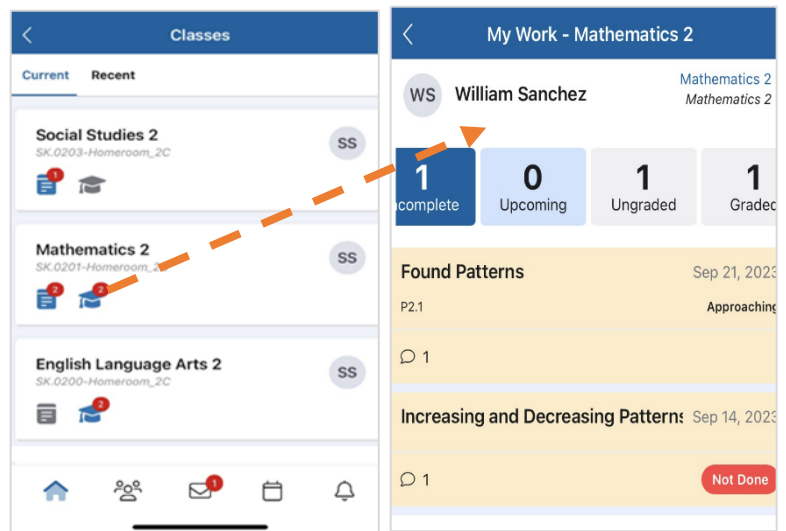
Parents can see an overview of the Classes their child is taking by clicking Classes below the name of their child on the Home Screen (while using the Edsby app)

**For Grades 10-12** you will see percentages for the student's overall grade if the teacher has chosen to share them.

**For Grades K-9** there will be no overall grade shown. Instead, each assessment will be graded using Beginning (BE), Approaching (AP), Meeting (ME) and Exemplary (EX).



Parents can view their child's grades in a class by clicking My Work below each Class. From here, parents will see overdue, incomplete, upcoming, ungraded, and graded assessments. Below each assessment listed, parents can see their child's submissions and score(s) for that assessment.



For grades K-9 what does BE, AP, ME and EX mean?

Beginning (BE)		Indicates a partial understanding. Even with reteaching and support the student struggles with the stated outcome.
Approaching (AP)		Indicates a basic understanding. Students at this level demonstrate an inconsistent understanding of the stated outcomes.
Meeting (ME)		Indicates a well-developed understanding of the grade level outcome. Students at this level are competent with the skills and knowledge identified in the outcome.
Exemplary (EX)		Indicates an insightful understanding of the grade level outcomes. Students at this level can apply and transfer knowledge to new situations.
